Croatian Prime Minister Andrej Plenkovic conducted a site visit to the historic Sister Of Mercy Hospital project renovated by Akfen Construction and Dost Construction

Croatian Prime Minister Andrej Plenkovic visited the Sister Of Mercy Hospital project in the capital city of Zagreb, which is being constructed by Akfen Construction - Dost Construction. Prime Minister Plenkovic was welcomed by Selim Akın, Vice Chairman and CEO of Akfen Holding, Mesut Coşkun Ruhi, General Manager of Akfen Construction, and project staff.

Established in 1895, the historic Sister Of Mercy Hospital covers an area of 110,000 square meters with 22 buildings. The project, which was contracted in November 2022 and began its planning phase, is being undertaken by Akfen Construction - Dost Construction and involves the renovation of the hospital damaged in the earthquake. The completion of the project is scheduled for 2025.

Akfen Construction, which has implemented significant infrastructure projects such as airport terminals, natural gas pipelines, hydroelectric power plants, and real estate projects both in **Turkey** and **abroad** since its establishment, hosted an important guest at the project it is continuing in the Croatian capital, **Zagreb**.

Croatian Prime Minister Andrej Plenkovic visited the Sister Of Mercy Hospital project under construction in the capital city of Zagreb by Akfen Construction and Dost Construction. **Croatian Prime Minister Andrej Plenkovic** was accompanied by the Minister of Health, Vili Beroš, and the Minister of Construction, Branko Bacic.

Welcomed by **Selim Akın, Vice Chairman and CEO of Akfen Holding, Mesut Coşkun Ruhi, General Manager of Akfen Construction**, and project staff, **Prime Minister Plenkovic** closely monitored the renovation works of the historic hospital and received information about the project.

COMPLETION OF THE WORKS IS PLANNED FOR 2025

Established in 1895 in the Croatian capital Zagreb, the historic Sister Of Mercy Hospital covers an area of 110,000 square meters with 22 buildings. The project, contracted in November 2022 and initiated its planning phase, is being undertaken by Akfen Construction and Dost Construction, including the renovation of the historic **Sister Of Mercy Hospital** damaged in the earthquake.

Within the scope of the project, 4 out of 6 existing buildings on the same campus **will be renovated**, and 2 buildings will be demolished and rebuilt completely.

The strengthening design phase of the Sister Of Mercy Hospital project is funded by the European Union Solidarity Fund, and the construction phase is financed by the Ministry of Health of the Croatian Government. The project is planned to be completed in 2025.
