

National Athlete Aysel Önder Rose to the Top in Portugal, Became World No. 1

Supported by Team Akfen İnşaat, national athlete Aysel Önder finished the 400-meter race she attended in Portugal in first place with a time of 55.26 seconds. Rising to world No. 1 in the 2026 IPC Ranking List with this result achieved in the T20 women's 400 meters, Aysel Önder once again demonstrated that she is the best in the world in her field.

Supported by Team Akfen İnşaat, National Athlete Aysel Önder achieved the success of being **"the best" in her field** by adding a new one to her achievements in the international arena. Taking the track in the **T20 Women's 400 Meter Race** at the organization held in **Portugal**, the national athlete came first by leaving her opponents behind with a time of 55.26 seconds.

Settling at the top of the 2026 IPC Ranking List with the degree she achieved in Portugal, National Athlete Aysel Önder became **world No. 1 in T20 women's 400 meters**.
